
International Research Collaborations

Research collaboration is important for both universities and global knowledgeintensive communities as the challenges facing the world will be more easily solved when universities work across borders and cultures






QS Asia University Rankings 2024


QS Asia University Rankings 2023: Number of institutions by country or territory














