

Funds have been allocated to send 70 professors and teachers for 3-6 month-long internships and advanced training in specialties and foreign languages in 2023 to foreign partner universities. The summer internship of at least 200 students abroad (Germany, Japan) under the Work&Travel program during the summer holidays is organized on a systematic basis.






The Internationalization Strategy of the University


Our University follows several principles to implement international educational activities. As a matter of fact, the University's participation in the global educational process confirms the success of the internationalization strategy. Some of the most important principles for the university are:

- International accreditation of educational programs by independent agencies that are members of international European networks for ensuring the quality of education;
- ➤ Cooperation in educational activities with foreign partner universities on joint training programs (Double Degree);
- Increasing the percentage of foreign citizens studying at the University;
- Attracting foreign specialists to top managerial positions and teaching academic subjects in English;
- Ensuring academic mobility of students and teachers (both incoming and outgoing);


- ➤ Recognition of credits received during the implementation of an academic program at another university, including a foreign one;
- Recognition of qualifications awarded by foreign universities to achieve new academic and professional goals;
- Participation in interdisciplinary international research networks aimed at solving global problems of humanity;
- > Export of educational services in the form of transnational and cross-border education;
- > Strengthening the university's position as a part of the global education system, by being accredited by international agencies, involved in the implementation of joint training programs for specialists, capable of exporting educational services.





















Main Goals for Our Academic Collaboration


Our University aims to achieve the following goals as a result of our academic collaboration with partner HEI's:

- ➤ Establishing a joint research & innovation centre at Tashkent State Transport University.


