












Changes in the Number of Top 100 Universities by Country (2004-2021)








Three universities enter the ARWU Top 100 list in 2021, including:

- Sun Yat-sen University (89th)
 from Chinese Mainland, which
 made its first-ever appearance in
 the Top 100.
- The Hebrew University of Jerusalem (90th) from Israel
- Technion-Israel Institute of Technology (94th) from Israel



Ranking Performance of "World-Class" Universities



Scholars and institutional administrators define "world-class" as attaining the standard to be included in the Lists of World University Rankings, which focuses on quality of education, internationalization, research output, status, and impact.

World-class universities play key roles in generating and circulating knowledge, educating highly skilled personnel for leadership, and serving the needs of society.

In ARWU 2021

- Germany has four universities ranked in the Top 100, namely the University of Munich (48th), Technical University of Munich (52th),
 Heidelberg University (57th) and University of Bonn (84th).
- Under the **French** Initiatives of Excellence (Initiatives D'Excellence), Paris-Saclay (13th), Sorbonne (35th), PSL (38th), and University of Paris (73th) hold four positions in the Top 100.
- The number of universities from **Chinese Mainland** continues to grow. Most of the listed universities are supported by the "Double World-Class Project" (World-Class Universities and World-Class Subjects Project).

About half of the universities ranked in ARWU are from Asia. 4 Universities from Saudi Arabia listed in the Top 500, comprise 17% of all the ranked universities.



Ranking Performance of Saudi Arabia Universities from 2004-2021








Candidates & Ranking Subjects


Universities need to have a minimum number of research publications during the period of five years. The publication threshold is different for different subjects.
