Rules of the competition for best thesis on academic ranking

Eligibility:

The competition is open to a PhD students who defended their thesis not earlier than 48 months before the date of application. The PhD thesis must be presented in English.

Award:

The prize for the winner is a grant of 2000 euro. In addition, the awardee can have the opportunity to present his/her research at the IREG Observatory annual IREG Conference. A certificate will be delivered to the awardee.

Criteria:

The PhD thesis will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- 1. Quality and originality of analysis
- 2. Contribution to good practice in academic ranking

Evaluation:

IREG Executive Committee will appoint an evaluation committee, whose members should not have any conflict of interest. Two members of the committee will evaluate each candidate.

Application:

Application should include

- 1. The Curriculum Vitae of the candidate
- 2. The Thesis of the candidate (in English), along with a 2 page summary highlighting the contribution of the PhD thesis to good practice in academic ranking.
- 3. A list of publications, manuscripts with the contribution of the candidate clearly specified.
- 4. A recommendation letter from the PhD advisor and/or a member of IREG Observatory
